Appreciation Tea

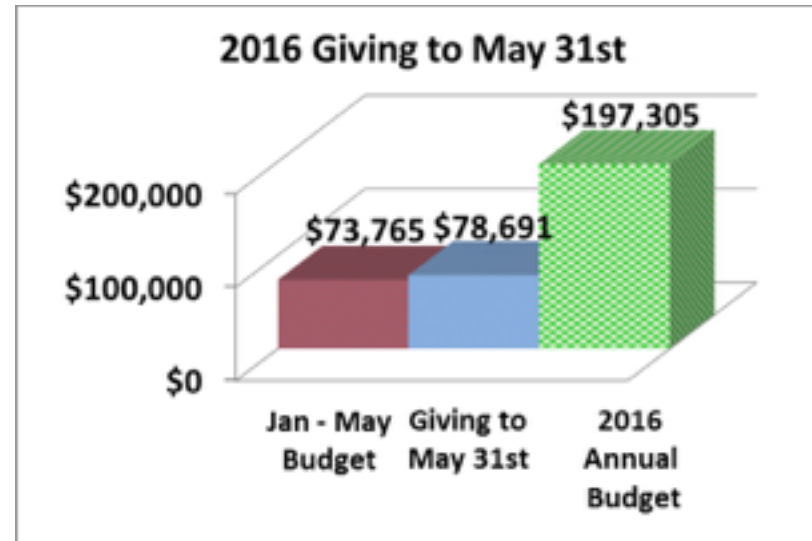

Summer Giving Announcement

Summer weather has arrived and with it, vacation time for many of us. To ensure Northview's financial position stays strong over the summer months, please remember your church when making get-away plans. Below are a couple options to ensure your giving remains uninterrupted:

1. Sign up for monthly pre-authorized giving. Application forms are available in the chair-back pockets in the sanctuary, attached to the electronic bulletin, and also are on the Northview web-site. When you fill out and sign the form, enclosing your banking information, then the specified giving amount will be automatically withdrawn from your account on the first of each month.
2. You can enclose post-dated cheque(s) for the time you will be away in a giving envelope, and place the envelope in the offering basket before heading off on vacation. We will deposit the cheque on the date indicated.
