#### **Easter Dates**


Here is what's happening at Northview over Easter:

- Easter Breakfast, following our walk we will enjoy sharing a meal together at 9:15 am.
- Easter Worship Service, this is our regular worship service at 10:30 am, but as we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus it is not business as usual!

#### **The Season of Lent**

"On Ash Wednesday, the church marks an important transition, beginning the great cycle of Easter that extends from Ash Wednesday to Pentecost. The season of Lent is not primarily a meditation on the suffering and cross of Christ; this is saved for Holy Week. Rather, it is a season of penitence and prayer, reflection and renewal, all designed to prepare the worshipping community for the remembrance of Christ's death and celebration of his resurrection during Holy Week. More specifically, Lent is preparation for baptism. For new Christians who are baptized on Easter, Lent is a time to prepare for their new identity in Christ. For those who have been baptized, it is a time of self-examination so that they might reclaim their identity as those who have been buried with Christ in baptism and raised with him to new life."
