Who's Coming to Dinner?

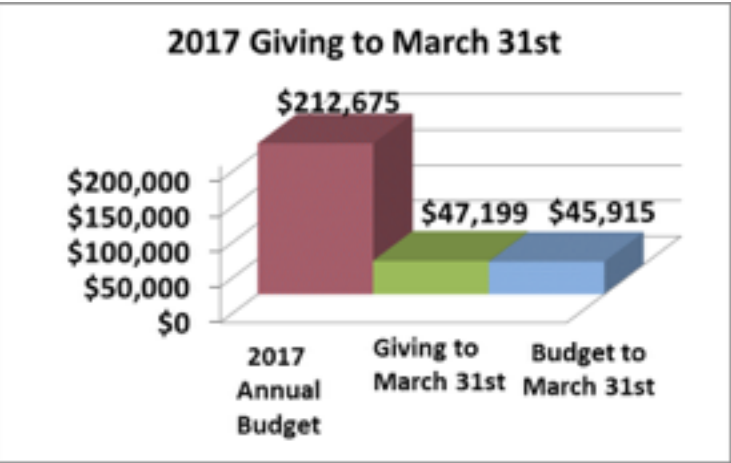
