Jason & Joanne's Journey Hurri to the Hills

A Dream turned into Reality

When we arrive in the Hurri Hills we will join a Brazilian couple who have been there for 8 years already. Five years ago, Ange, the wife, had a dream about a certain location. She was sure it was God sharing something powerful for that specific location. Years went by and nothing happened there. Two years ago, a lodge was built in that location, which seemed like a step backwards from Ange's dream. But recently the lady who manages that lodge sent Ange a message that she would like the missionaries to come and do fellowship in her lodge. During their first visit many people came. One lady said that she saw how the people in the other villages acted when they gathered to learn about Jesus, and so she wanted to start following Jesus too. From now on they will have weekly fellowship in the lodge, right in the spot that Ange dreamed about.

Facts About the Gabra

What is the population of the Gabra? 31,000.
About 400 families are in the area we will be living in.

What do the Gabra eat? The Gabra eat mostly maize (non-sweet corn), ugali (ground maize mixed with boiling water to make a paste), and kidney beans. They also love black tea with milk and sugar.

What language do the Gabra speak? Oromo. There is very little English or Swahili in the Hurri Hills.

A Church on the Move



The Gabra church pictured here moved this month. Since the Gabra are nomadic and move around, it only makes sense that when the people move, so does their church. This church is now in a better location where more people can come and hear what the Bible says.




