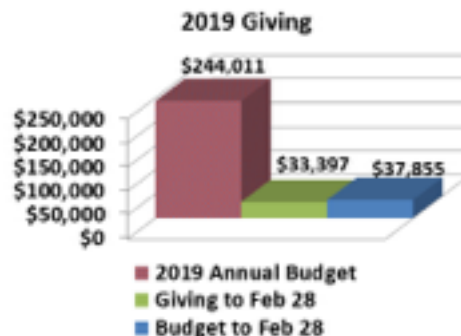
## Discovery Land Children's Programming
