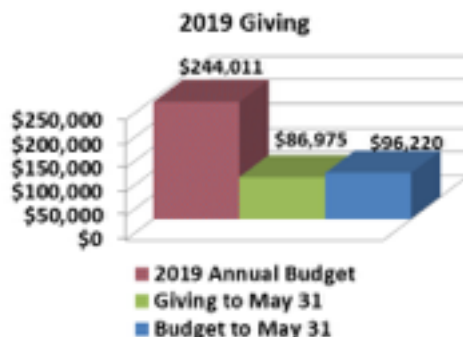
Discovery Land Children's Programming
