Discovery Land Children's Programming

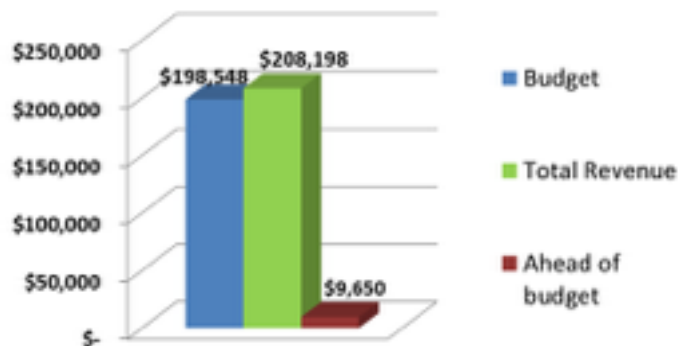

Roof Loan

As reported earlier this year Northview's board hired Hunter's Construction to replace the large half of the roof on our church as well as the garage. Both look great! Due to COVID we decided to take a loan of \$25,000 from FMCiC rather than try to fundraise during difficult times. In November we began to repay that loan at \$570 per month (to be paid over four years). Therefore, you will notice on this years proposed budget an additional cost of \$6,840 for loan repayment.
