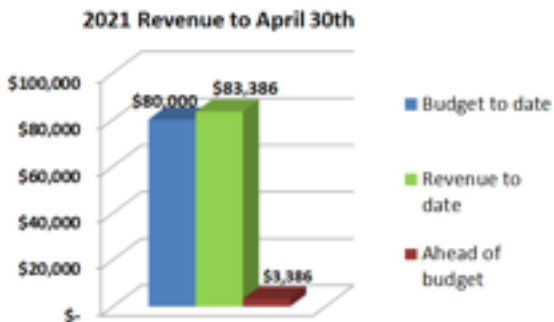
## Discovery Land Children's Programming

It is with great excitement that Northview's Board has prayerfully decided to reopen its doors Sunday, June 13th! Our Sunday morning service will be similar to what it was like before we closed in the fall/winter of 2020. As Saskatchewan Health Authority restrictions begin to lighten, so will our Sunday morning services. We will continue to hold our online service if you feel more comfortable with that medium. Whether you are a staff member, a partner in the church or a visitor, we respect your decision not to attend in person for health or personal reasons. ### FMCiC Online Service June 6th

On June 6th there is an online church service provided by the Free Methodist Church in Canada, our national denomination, because of the General Conference that is held on this weekend. Northview will not have an online service that day but we encourage you to join our brothers and sisters in Christ across the nation for this gathering on YouTube. More information will be released as it becomes available. It would be wonderful for you to join.

### General Conference

Every three years the Free Methodist Church in Canada (FMCiC) holds a general conference. Normally we would send the church delegate and some of the pastoral staff to Mississauga to attend. This is a time to network, learn and reflect on current and future ministries. Due to the pandemic, the general conference was postponed last year and will be held online June 5th and 6th this year. It has been suggested by our FMCiC denomination to provide all pastoral staff a one week sabbatical leading up to the conference in order to give our pastors the time to reflect on ministries.
