## Northview Kids

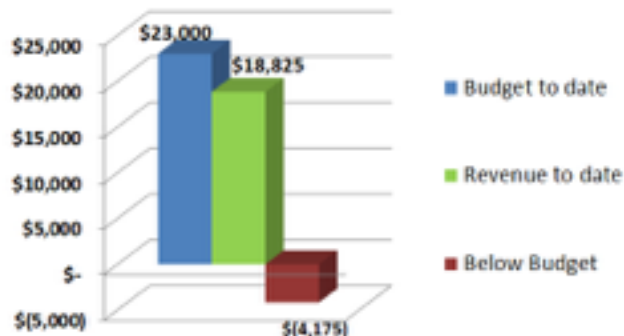

### Ash Wednesday Service

We will be having our Ash Wednesday service on **Wednesday, February 14<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm**. Ash Wednesday begins the Lenten Season, which provides 40 days of reflection, examination, and repentance in order to be prepared to once again encounter the cross and resurrection of Jesus in the Easter Season. Ash Wednesday begins us reflecting on our humanity: we are sinful (we hide ourselves away from God) and we are mortal (as a result of cutting ourselves off from the true source of life, God, we will die). But Ash Wednesday ultimately finishes with hope. The ashes, which symbolize our sin and death, are placed in the shape of the cross, reminding us that greater than our sin is God's grace and greater than our death is God's new life—everlasting.
