Northview Kids

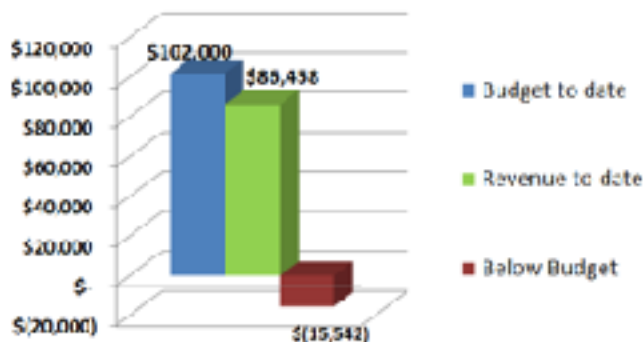
