Exploring Our Identity: A Limited Series on Who We Are

Howard Snyder is one of the foremost experts on Wesleyan theology, history, and practice. Over the years Snyder has helped the Free Methodist Church better understand its own identity by examining the traditional streams that have come together to form the movement.

As can be seen in the image above, the Free Methodist Church draws on four main streams: Anglo-Catholic, Evangelical, Charismatic, and Anabaptist.

Over the next several weeks we will explore how each one of these streams contribute to our larger Free Methodist identity. We will also see how we differ from those sources as we bring

together the streams to create something new. The word 'synthesis' is crucial for understanding that we are not simply a buffet of different traditions. We're more of a stew!

It's also important to note that the arrows that move from these respective traditions to our synthesis also point back to each tradition. This represents the way that our synthesis has resulted in influencing those traditions too. We have made a contribution to the larger Christian world.

Why don't you take some time this weekend to reflect on how each of these traditions have come together to shape who you are as a Christian?

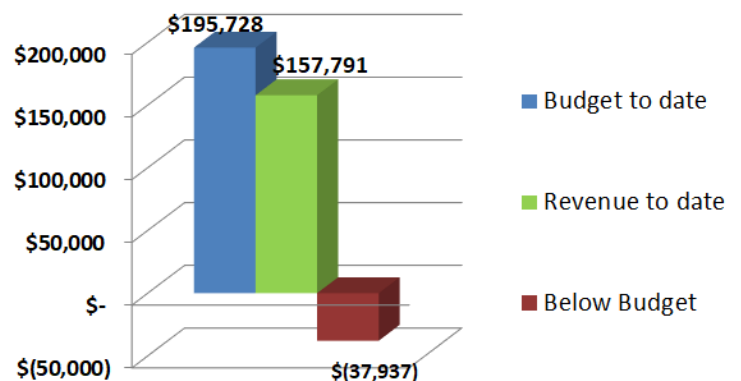
