Genealogies

A few weeks ago, Joanne and a friend were listening to a recording of Luke 3 on her phone. They had Olivia with them, and were smiling and playing with Olivia while they listened. At the end of the chapter is a genealogy of Jesus. As soon as the genealogy started, the friend picked up the phone, holding it to her ear so that she could listen intently. She did that until the end of the genealogy. For the Gabra, genealogies are very important. Everyone, including young kids, are able to list off the names of their ancestors for many generations. Knowing where people fit in the Gabra ancestry is very important, so hearing the ancestry of Jesus is something that they are eager to listen to.

Sermon Prep

When we first moved to Hurri Hills, all of the preaching was done by missionaries. Now, it is mostly done by three Gabra men. They go together and preach in three different villages every week. Two of the men who preach only speak Gabra, so there is no Bible school that we can send them to. As part of discipling these younger church leaders, Jason and Gustavo have started to meet once a week with these men to go over their sermon, checking for accuracy, but also to teach and encourage them as they continue to learn how to preach and lead the local churches.

Audio Bibles

Last week at Joanne's ladies Bible Study, a friend mentioned that she was charging her audio Bible (they have a small solar panel to charge in the sun) on the roof of her house when it started to rain. It got damaged, and she was wondering if she could have a new one. This spurred a few other women to ask for audio Bibles too. Since then, we have seen/heard some of them using the audio Bibles as we walk through the village. It is great to see people excited to listen to and read the Bible.

Nairobi Travels

Next week we will head down to Nairobi. AIM's annual conference is always at the end of November. Plus, Olivia needs a checkup with her doctor, and we need some supplies after being in the bush for 3 months. One of our main highlights of the conference is always being able to worship in English. We look forward to being refreshed and being back in Hurri Hills for Christmas.
