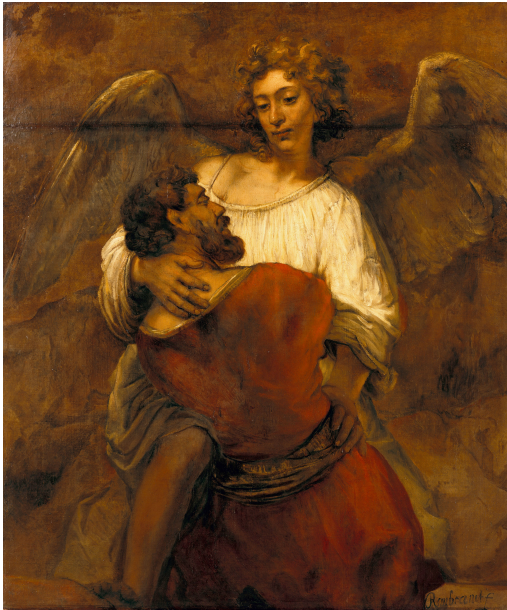

Wrestling with God: A Reflection on Last Week's Sermon

I hope *When Things Fall Apart* has been a difficult sermon series for you. I hope this, not because I wish a difficult life for you, but because I hope for an honest life for you.

Real life contains tragedy even for followers of God—maybe especially for them. The difference between those who walk with Jesus and those who don't ought to be in the way that we hold our pain.

Where the world demands a mutually beneficial relationship with God or belief will be abandoned, the Christian realizes there is nowhere else to turn but to the Lord of the universe. Like Jacob, we grip onto God and refuse to release him until he brings new life.

Of course, that means there is a cost; the old life must be abandoned. God will only give us today's bread, never yesterday's.

So, along with the status quo that yesterday represents, we also abandon the old identity that went with it. Jacob becomes Israel, and limps away from his encounter with God forever changed.

This is precisely what it means to be a follower of Jesus, and it is why discipleship begins in baptism. To enter into the new life, we must put to death our old self and be raised to our new Christ-self. It is only through the laying down of our lives that we may truly have life.

And, each time things fall apart, this is a fresh opportunity to lay it down again for him.

Prayer for Pastor Natasha

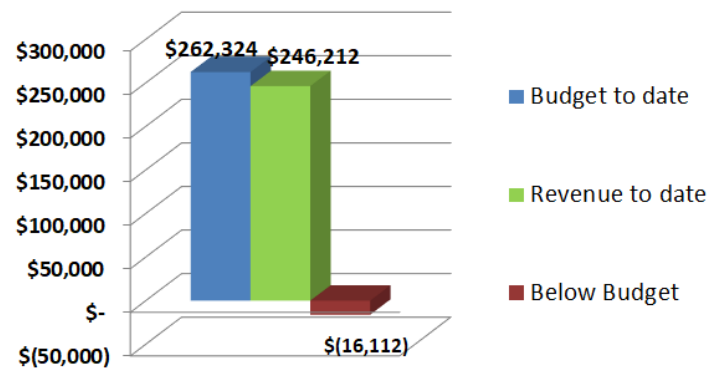
