2026 Regional Gathering

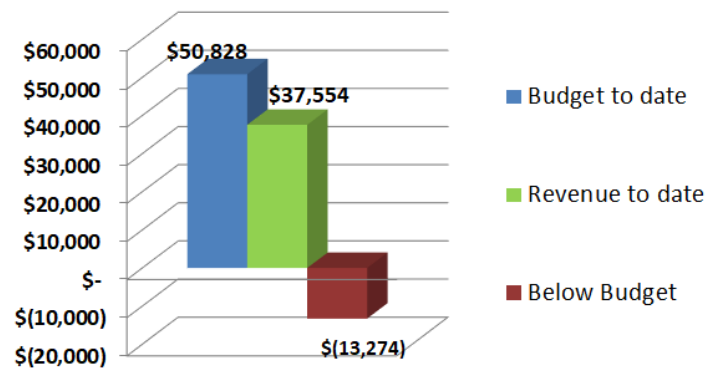
