



Jesus's Resurrection, New Life: A Reflection on Last Week's Sermon

The Gospel writers do more than tell us that Jesus was put to death on the cross. They emphasize that he was thoroughly killed. This is part of the point of the soldiers piercing Jesus's side and having blood and water flow out. These evangelists want their audiences to know that Jesus could not have been resuscitated. Such injuries would have caused him simply to die a second time.

What they do testify to is that Jesus was raised *from* the dead. Death had done its worst on Jesus. It could do no more. When Jesus was raised, he was raised to a new life, a new creation that is not only not ruled by death, but death has no part of it. That's why even

though Jesus was raised with his wounds, he did not die from them a second time. The life of the new creation is animated by the Spirit of the new age, not by the flesh of the old age.

And it is because Jesus has entered the new creation that the way has been opened for you and me. Even more important, our incorporation into the new creation is not merely in the future. It is ours now. Hear the words of Paul in Ephesians 2:4–6:

But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved. And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus.

Volunteer Opportunity

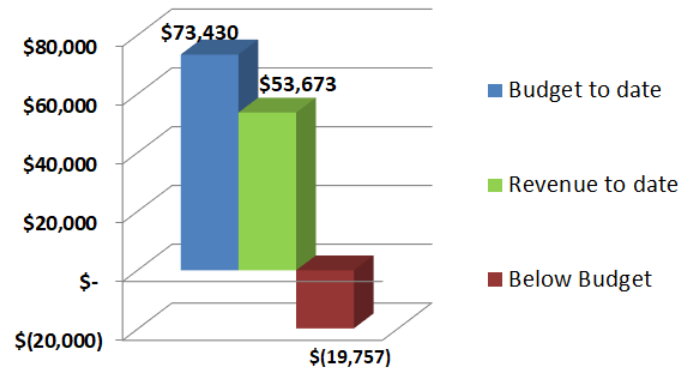
As Pastor David transitions, we are looking for someone who will take on Communion set up and take down on the first of the month, beginning in June. If you are interested, please contact Pastor David.
