



## Keep Anchored: A Reflection on Last Week's Sermon

"If the devil can't make you sin, he'll make you busy," declares Corrie ten Boom. And we have to admit that we are busier than ever today. Busy doesn't mean we are doing anything meaningful. Often our busyness consists in consuming media or scrolling through our phones. A lot of the time, we are busy with distractions.

Corrie ten Boom's point is that in the midst of our distraction and busyness the devil has a ready, and often, willing victim to destroy. The other part of her point is that the destruction that the devil brings is not necessarily sudden and violent. We could say the devil cuddles us into destruction. Just check out C. S. Lewis's *Screwtape Letters* to see what that might

look like.

The author of the Letter to the Hebrews knows only too well how distractible we are as a species, so he gives the warning that we must pay the most careful attention so that we do not drift away.

His corresponding point is that the kingdom that we now inhabit through Christ is too precious to let slip through our fingers. The salvation that comes to us through God's only Son should not be treated like a gym membership at the YMCA.

We could summarize the point by saying: you have been made a member of God's family through the precious sacrifice of God's Son. Treat that gift for what it's worth by guarding against its loss. Instead, remain anchored in this life.

### Volunteer Opportunity

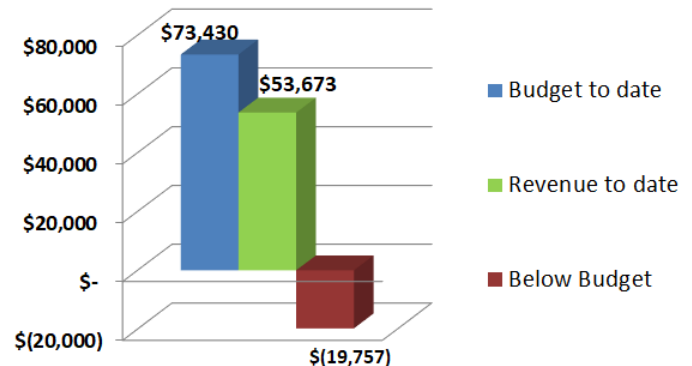
As Pastor David transitions, we are looking for someone who will take on Communion set up and take down on the first of the month, beginning in June. If you are interested, please contact Pastor David.
