



Christ Our High Priest: A Word on the Sermon We Didn't Have Last Week

Our text for last week was Hebrews 9:11–22. It would be worth your while to read the passage! For now, here's verses 13–14:

The blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that they are outwardly clean. How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!

One of the questions that the church has wrestled with throughout its history is: how can we know that salvation is effective? Do you ever wonder this sort of thing: how do I know that I am saved?

The author of the letter to the Hebrews is providing us with an

answer. He or she is using a logical technique, moving from the 'lesser' to the 'greater.' The argument moves like this: If the blood of animals can sanctify people externally (and it can), then the blood of Christ can surely cleanse us internally (and it does)!

This is the pattern of the whole letter: everything that the first covenant provided was good, but limited. But the new covenant, made by the blood of Christ Jesus, the Son, fulfills the work of the first covenant and also accomplishes all that the first covenant wanted to do.

In short, how may we know that we are saved and saved to the fullest? Because God has accomplished our salvation through the precious blood of the eternal Son, who offered himself unblemished for us.

Volunteer Opportunity

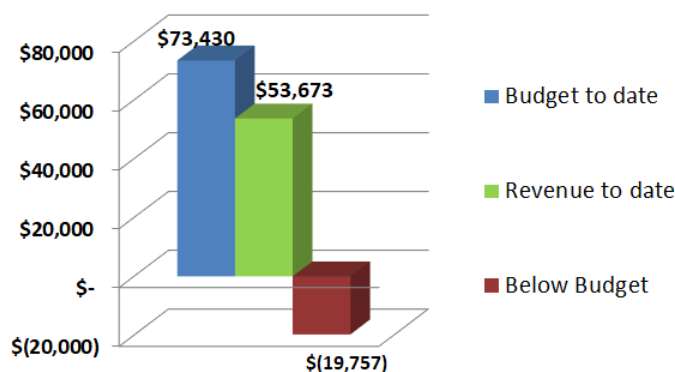
As Pastor David transitions, we are looking for someone who will take on Communion set up and take down on the first of the month, beginning in June. If you are interested, please contact Pastor David.
