The Goodness of Creation: A Reflection on Last Week's Sermon

Last Sunday, we reviewed the creation account found in Genesis chapter 1. One of the things we noticed in passing was that after each day of creation, God declared what he had made to be good. And then, when creation was complete, the author says "God saw all that he had made, and it was very good" (Genesis 1:31a).

Scripture's perspective on the created order is that it is good in its parts and it is good as a whole. What could it mean for creation to be good and very good? It means that it is, it exists in accordance with God's will. Before any other word or plot development, the Bible says the world, and you and me, are good. Even very good.

Of course, the story doesn't end there. Crisis enters into the story of God and his world, which thickens the plot and complicates the relationship. Humanity sins, choosing to attempt to have life apart from God. Instead of holding onto the good, we desired to know evil as well.

Clearly, Scripture now uses the language of 'the world' in negative ways, and human beings are compromised, choosing evil instead of good. However, does this mean that creation and humanity, as the pinnacle of creation, are no longer good, bound for destruction?

No. The gospel—incarnation, death, resurrection, and ascension—tells us creation, and we are bound for renewal because we are good & God's!

Baby Shower

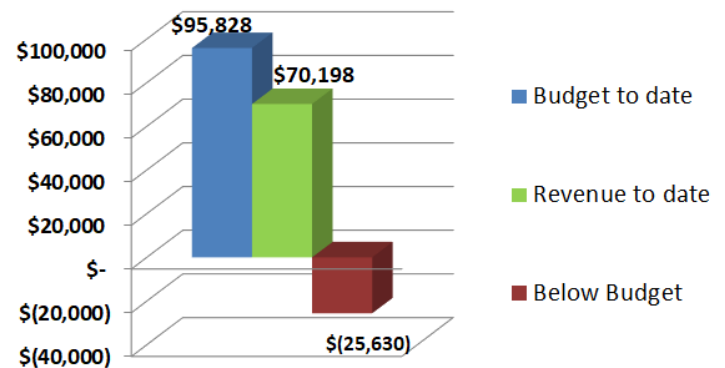
