



Worship As Practice: A Reflection on Last Week's Sermon

Worship is the pinnacle of the church's practice. In fact, all that the church does is done in the offer of worship. And this is not just true of the church collectively. It must also be true of each of us personally.

Our worship is our whole life offering to God through the Spirit in Christ. This, of course, is what baptism is. It is a figurative, but also literal, submission of our lives to the Lordship of Christ. And that kind of offering can only be done by faith.

This is true because we cannot see exactly what we are doing. It's very much like marriage. In marriage we are making vows that we don't actually know

what they entail. We don't even really know the person we are marrying.

When we make our vow to Jesus through the waters of baptism, we are committing a life that is not our own and a future we aren't aware of yet. So this life and this future can only be submitted to God by faith.

If we were to be able to see what exactly a life surrendered to God entails, we would be inclined to say, 'No, thank you.'

By faith we 'see' not the life that the world promises, but the life God has promised to us as his adopted children and inheritors of his creation. Only by such sight, the sight of faith, are we able to commit ourselves saying, it is no longer I that lives but Christ lives in me.

- 2) Complete New Life Plan Process

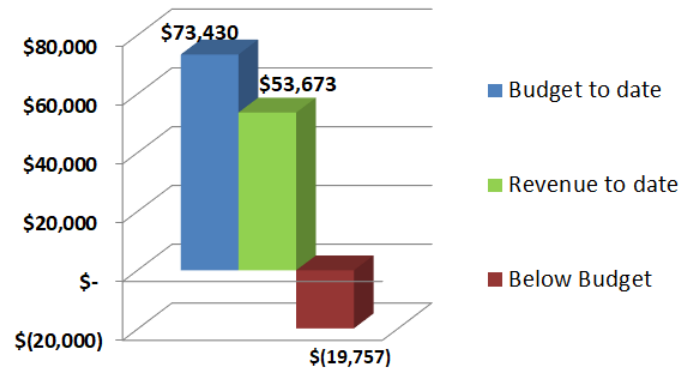
